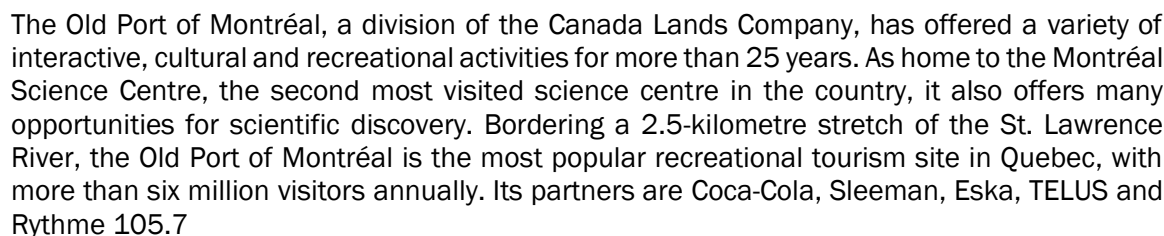
Guinness World Records at the Science Centre this Summer
